School wide we will be enjoying some fun activities.

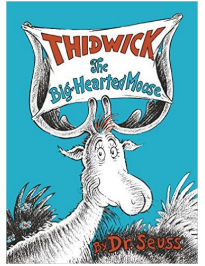
Monday (Feb 27) – Fox In Socks – Wear Crazy Socks
