PRODUCTIONS COMPANY AUDITIONS – 8th GRADE ONLY

We are excited to offer a new Theatre elective next year for current 8th grade (incoming 9th graders) only. The class is called “Productions Company” and the entire class will be dedicated to staging and putting on a full-length play. This will be a straight play (not a musical) and is completely unaffiliated with our after school musicals. All rehearsals will be in class and through the class every day we will cover advanced theatre standards. The play is not 100% set-in-stone yet but Mr. Langlois has some cool ideas in the works.

Entrance to this class will be given by audition only. Auditions for Productions Company will be **Wednesday May 10 from 3:00-5:00** in Mr. Langlois classroom. Students should sign-up for auditions outside his classroom. There is no need to prepare anything. Auditions are in group format where students will play some games, cold read monologues and improvise scenes to show off their skills as actors (there’s no singing because it is not a musical). Students will need to bring a completed audition form on the 10th which they can get when they sign up. The class list will be posted the next morning outside Mr. Langlois room and students on the list will be guaranteed a spot in the class next Fall.
