PARKING LOT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

There have been many concerns voiced to both myself and the office staff regarding the safety of the parking lot during drop off and pick up. Our first and for most priority is the safety of the students, so please be patient and follow all of the procedures. Please drive slowly and attentively. It is not worth an injury to a child just to shave off seconds off your time.

- When you are dropping students off or picking students up, please remember to pull as far forward as possible to allow for more cars along the drop off zone.
- Do NOT summon your students across the parking lot to your parked car. Students should NOT cross the parking lot without an adult escort. If you are parking, get out of your car and come to the curb to get your students.
- If you are using the southern most parking lot (the city parking lot), please use only the southern egress.
- Again be patient and attentive.

ORANGE CONES

The orange cones that are placed in various areas of the parking lot are NOT to be moved, driven over or gone around! They are there to ensure proper traffic flow. The first egress is coned off because of the proximity to the light, and the way the ingress opens into the stacking lanes. This decision was made long before the school opened by engineers, safety officials and others with extensive school parking lot knowledge, who determined that using just one entrance/exit was the safest way to move the greatest number of cars through the parking lot
