Guidelines:

Costumes must be modest and not compromise safety standards

- Bottoms must be worn high enough on waist that underwear or skin is not exposed.
- No clothing that displays obscene, vulgar, lewd, or sexually explicit words, messages or pictures.

Costumes have many components to them. Your child may not be able to wear his/her entire costume to school. Please understand. Please NO: masks, blood, gore, weapons or items that resemble weapons. Please keep face paint to a minimum as it dries out and becomes uncomfortable through out the day. Hair coloring is acceptable. Hats and headgear will be allowed as long as they do not distract the learning environment. Teachers may ask a student to remove hats or headgear.
